This can be done with 2 puppets, 2 people, or 1 of each. Feel free to change anything you like as long as the basic point remains. The script was written by an Englishman, so those across the pond might want to change the odd word here and there.

Mike: Hi Tracey, how are you?

Tracey: I'm fine, thank you. And you?

Mike: I'm well, thanks. I was wondering... what are you doing tomorrow?

Tracey: Well, I'm washing my hair, washing my clothes, washing the car...

Mike: That's a lot of washing, but how do you know?

Tracey: That's just what I'm going to do tomorrow.

Mike: But how do you know?

Tracey: Erm, I've just planned to do those things.

Mike: So you don't really know then?

Tracey: What do you mean, Mike?

Mike: For all you know, someone might be about to give you an all expenses paid trip to a posh hotel with all the best food and drink and pampering and stuff.

Tracey: Oh Mike, you shouldn't have!

Mike: Oh, I haven't.

Tracey: (Disappointed) Oh.

Mike: I was just saying that we don't know what's going to happen in the future.

Tracey: I suppose you're right, but God knows.

Mike: You what?

Tracey: God knows what's going to happen tomorrow, and the next day, and the day after that and basically forever.

Mike: How do you know?

Tracey: You're just being awkward now aren't you?

Mike: No, seriously, how do you know that God knows the future?

Tracey: Well, the Bible says that God knows everything.

Mike: Yes, but he can't know about stuff that hasn't happened yet. That's impossible!

Tracey: The Bible also says that nothing is impossible for God.

Mike: Well yes, but I still don't get it. If something hasn't happened yet, how could God know about it?
